<Artist Statement >

We live each day surrounded by countless boundaries.

Inside and outside, consciousness and unconsciousness, memory and the present, self and other—these boundaries are not fixed, but, like breathing, continuously expand and contract.

This exhibition presents works that explore the multilayered nature of the human inner world and its deepest core through the sculptural language of form. By allowing boundaries and spaces to permeate one another, the works attempt to dismantle and reconstruct the contours of the "self" as a fixed concept.

The "breathing boundaries" evoked by this series of works are not fixed lines of separation, but membrane-like entities that pulse in rhythm with life itself. When one stands before the works, these boundaries resonate with the viewer's inner rhythm, generating new harmonies of vibration. Through the interplay of primal memory and the senses, the works seek to create moments in which a deep, pre-linguistic form of communication comes into being.

Through this exhibition, I hope viewers will become aware of the "boundaries" that usually remain unnoticed in daily life—and sense that these are not fixed divisions, but dynamic entities that breathe together with life itself. May this awareness serve as an opportunity to open new horizons of self-understanding. Nature and humanity, presence and absence—the doorway to deeper understanding quietly resides beyond these "breathing boundaries."
